
#### **From Pastor Stirdivant**



Day 1: "Be strong and courageous...God is with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9



"The Lord gives wisdom...knowledge and understanding." Proverbs 2:6



Day 3:

"Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us." Daniel 3:17

Three young men in the Bible story today were captives. They were far away from their homeland. The king had them serving in his government, and they were living in a culture that didn't honor the one true God. God works through us wherever we are, even as captives! In Bible times, when two countries went to war, the winning king would sometimes take people of the losing country captive. Those people might be put to work for that king. We discovered how God was at work through these captives! Jesus saves us!



Day 4: "Faith... is the gift of God." Ephesians 2:8

In the Bible story on the fourth day of VBS we learned of a humble blind man named Bartimaeus. He was a beggar. In New Testament times, blind people could not work and had to beg for food and money. Bartimaeus depended on the compassion and mercy of the people who passed by him on the road between Jericho and Jerusalem for the things he needed to live. We discovered how Jesus is at work through this humble beggar! Jesus gives us faith!



Day 5: "We love because He first loved us." 1 John 4:19

In the Bible story on the fifth day we heard about a man named Ananias. We don't know a lot about Ananias. For example, we don't know how he made a living. But the Bible tells us that Ananias had the vocation of disciple. When Jesus gives us faith, He calls us to the vocation of disciple. A disciple of Jesus follows Jesus by studying and believing His Word. We discovered how Jesus was at work through his disciples! Jesus gives us His love to share!
